We at **St Lorient Fashion & Art Gallery** hosted a **ROOFTOP VII** group exhibition.

Opening: **26th July 2015**.

TITLE: *THE INNER CHILD*

Following on the successes of the expansive previous six Rooftop Sculpture exhibitions held at St Lorient Art and Fashion Gallery in Pretoria , ROOFTOP VII 2015 will have a more *playful and whimsical theme*. The sculptures should aim to bring out the inner child in us and should be uplifting.

Artists have previously used materials and forms suitable for the outdoors and have worked on a scale that makes the pieces suitable for a rooftop or garden / parkland setting and have a sense of monumentality to them. Works should be able to withstand the elements.

We are going with larger type of sculptures that are monumentally scaled so they are visible from the street.

Some can look over the roof top others can be suspended and dangling over the edge of the roof.

The artist must try and use diverse textures to come up with a sculpture.

The sculptures should encourage interaction with the viewer.

For example, Gordon Froud has an idea for a bright plastic mobile to hang over the edge.

We would also like to invite the sculptors participating in the Rooftop Exhibition to also exhibit smaller pieces in the ground floor exhibition space.
